SPPD UPPER RED LAKE ROCK NECKLACES

This SPPD Necklace has been created with a rock collected from the shores of Upper Red Lake. The glacier carried the rock down, depositing it near Waskjish, Minnesota. About 12,000 years ago, the glacier left, creating Lake Agassiz, which covered large portions of Northern Minnesota—200 miles wide and extending 700 miles north into Canada. We don't know how old your rock is, but is surely came from that period.

Retired Lt. Joe Corcoran finds the rocks, and his wife Karen creates your jewelry with the SPPD patch as a fundraiser for the Saint Paul Police Historical Society. Each stone is unique, and the patch honors our great department. Enjoy and value the history behind this beautiful piece of Minnesota that honors Saint Paul's finest.
